

# Chile from North to South

## Day 1.

Europe – Santiago de Chile:

Departure on an international flight to Santiago de Chile. Night on board.

## Day 2.

Santiago de Chile:

Arrival at the airport. Reception and private transfer to the Selected Hotel. Accommodation.

## Day 3.

Santiago de Chile:

Private excursion through the city discovering the Bellavista neighborhood, the Central Market, Mapocho Station and the Museum of Fine Arts. A guided tour will allow you to discover the Santa Lucia Hill and Santiago's Plaza de Armas, from where you can see the Cathedral of Santiago, the Municipality, the Post Office and the National Historical Museum. The trip will continue with a panoramic view of the former National Congress and La Moneda, the Government Palace of Chile. The traditional neighborhoods Club Hípico, Universitario and Concha y Toro will be part of the itinerary. The day will conclude with a panoramic walk through the Modern Santiago.

## Day 4.

Santiago de Chile:

Full day exclusive excursion to the city of Viña del Mar, known as "The Garden City", for its colorful parks and gardens. You will visit the Quinta Vergara, the Carrasco Palace and the Flores clock. The port of Valparaíso, declared a World Heritage Site by Unesco, will be the last link in the route. In the afternoon, return to Santiago.

## Day 5.

Santiago de Chile – Calama – San Pedro de Atacama:

Private transfer to the airport to board the flight that will take you to the airport of Calama. Reception and private transfer to the selected Hotel. In the afternoon excursion to the Valley of the Moon and Death, first approach to the high plateau. Accommodation.



## Day 6.

San Pedro de Atacama:

Private excursion to The Salt Flat of Atacama, one of the most important in the world due to its great extension. There, you can marvel at the three types of flamingos that inhabit Chile. Over the 4,300 meters of altitude, you will visit the Miscanti and Miñique lagoons, with blue waters, born from the melting of homonymous volcanoes. Finally, you will visit the town of Toconao, its main square, the bell tower built in 1750 with adobe and cactus wood, and the church of San Lucas.

## Day 7.

San Pedro de Atacama:

Full day private excursion to the high plateau, reaching 4,320 meters above sea level, to visit one of the most important geothermal fields in the world, the Tatio Geysers. Thanks to cold and extreme temperatures, you can see large columns of steam. On the way back you will visit The Putano's wetlands, where you will appreciate different species of birds, the imposing Colorado volcano and the town of Machuca, where the original altiplanic architecture is reflected by its church.

## Day 8.

San Pedro de Atacama – Calama – Santiago de Chile – Puerto Montt – Puerto Varas:

Private transfer to the airport to board the flight to Puerto Montt. Reception and regular transfer to the selected hotel in Puerto Varas. Accommodation.

## Day 9.

Puerto Varas:

Private half-day excursion to the city of Frutillar. Departing from the hotel you will go along the shore of Lake Llanquihue until you reach Frutillar, a peaceful city, full of stories of German settlers who broke through adversity and made this area flourish. With lively gardens, colorful houses, tea rooms and its large German Colonial Museum, which shows the history of the German settlement in the region.

## Day 10.

Puerto Varas:

Full day excursion in private service to the Island of Chiloe. It starts in the direction of the town of Paragua, famous for the hospitality of its people who continue to maintain their customs and myths due to their isolation from the continent. After sailing for 30 minutes through the Pacific Ocean, through the Chacao Channel, you will arrive at the town of the same name, previous step to reach the city of Ancud, where you will visit the viewpoint of



Huaihuen Hill, San Antonio's Fort (an old spanish fort), the Interactive and Artisanal Museum, the Municipal Market, the center and the Costanera Avenue.

### *Day 11.*

Puerto Varas Port – Puerto Montt – Punta Arenas – Puerto Natales:

Private transfer to the airport to board the flight to Punta Arenas. Arrival and private transfer to Puerto Natales. Reception and transfer to the selected Hotel. Accommodation.

### *Day 12.*

Puerto Natales:

Full day private excursion to Torres del Paine National Park and Milodón Cave. This day you will enjoy the most diverse landscapes such as the Magellanic forest, the vast Patagonian steppe dominated by the wind, lakes populated by seabirds and with a deep turquoise color, waterfalls and snowy mountains. You will discover the lakes Nordenskjold and Pehoé. After lunch, an entertaining walk along the shore will allow you to get to Gray Lake to see the blue icebergs and the glacier in the background. In the afternoon, return to Puerto Natales.

### *Day 13.*

Puerto Natales:

Excursion navigating the Last Hope Fjord to see the Balmaceda and Serrano glaciers, on the way you can see the Frigorifico Bories, one of the largest meat processing industries in Patagonia. In addition, you will see a colony of Imperial Cormorants, a small colony of sea lions and an important variety of Patagonian flora, after lunch you will disembark for a walk to the Serrano Glacier.

### *Day 14.*

Puerto Natales – Punta Arenas - Santiago:

Private transfer to Punta Arenas Airport, where you will board the flight to Santiago. Reception and transfer to the selected Hotel. Accommodation.
